



2024 GILROY ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP & AWARDS

The Gilroy Rotary Club Scholarship and Awards Program will be offering up to \$97,500.00 in college scholarships to the following:

- Qualified Gilroy area high school seniors graduating in 2024 who will enter their first year of college in Fall 2024; and
- Gavilan College or other students who are transferring to a four-year college in Fall 2024.

The scholarships are as follows:

Goldsmith/Gilroy Rotary Horticulture/Biological Sciences Scholarship(s): up to \$7,500 total scholarships.

These scholarships are specifically designed for students planning a career in Horticulture, Plant Science, Biology, or a related field.

(These awards are also available to Gavilan College students in these fields who are transferring to a four-year college).

To qualify for the Goldsmith Scholarship, applicants must:

- live in Gilroy or be attending a Gilroy High School or Gavilan College
- have an excellent record of service in the community and/or extracurricular activities
- graduate from high school or Gavilan College in June 2024.
- A minimum 3.0 GPA for the last two years is required.

Susan J. Seledon/Rotary Continuing College Scholarship: Two scholarships of \$15,000 each (\$7500 per year for two years),

These are designed to assist individuals who have completed their first two years of college education, and who have demonstrated their potential for success.

Applicants must be returning to school after an interruption in their education. To qualify for this scholarship, students must also be transferring to a four-year-college in Fall 2024.

To qualify for the Susan J. Seledon Continuing College Scholarship, applicants must:

- be a resident of South Santa Clara County or North San Benito County,
- or have attended Gavilan or Hartnell Community College.
- Have had an interruption in studies for a few years, and
- Be transferring to a four-year college in Fall 2024



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Susan J. Seledon/Rotary Fine Arts Scholarship: Up to \$20,000 total – Up to \$5000 per year for up to four years while the student remains in the art major.

- This scholarship is designed for a student who will be pursuing a four-year college degree in traditional 2D painting, drawing, or a graphic fine art.

Susan J. Seledon/Rotary First Generation College Scholarship: Up to two scholarships for \$20,000 each – Up to \$5,000 per year for up to four years.

- These two scholarships are designed for students who will be the first in their immediate family to attend a four-year college

Pointers to complete this application packet successfully:

Scholarship Application: Be sure to answer all questions. Do not leave blanks. Each answer is essential in determining your qualifications for this scholarship. Please contact your school counselor or advisor for resources and assistance in completing this application.

The Checklist: Use the check-off boxes on the last page of the application packet to be sure that you have collected and turned in all required items.

Essay: Provide a maximum 250-word essay to reflect your experience in community and extracurricular activities. It should express what your involvement in Gilroy has meant to you. You should also explain your higher education and career goals. When your application essay is complete, it must be WORD-PROCESSED AND PROOFREAD to ensure correct grammar, spelling, and punctuation. Students are encouraged to ask for help to make sure their applications are error-free.

Resume: A Personal Resume which should include:

- Academic Achievements
- Extracurricular activities
- Volunteer work
- Job History
- Other awards or recognitions

Submission of Completed Application: Have all required transcripts and other pages contained in the application packet completed before you turn in your application. Your application will not be considered if it is not complete. It is also a good idea to keep a photocopy of your completed application for your records.

Notification: All valid applicants will be notified by mail of the determination made on their application.
